Rise Technical Reports Show No Significant Environmental Impacts for Idaho-Maryland Mine Project *

- All Technical Reports required for Draft Environmental Impact Report complete.
- Technical Reports conclude that IM Project has no significant environmental impacts after mitigation.
- The final judgement of the significance of impacts and mitigation measures are determined by the County in consultation with its independent consultant.
- Preparation of Draft Environmental Impact Report to commence shortly.
